PhD Sinisa Jasic was born in Grab, Bijelo Polje Municipality, Republic of Montenegro on May 1, 1965. He finished primary and secondary school in Bijelo Polje. He graduated from the Faculty of Physical Education, University of Novi Sad in 1991. He received his master's degree from the same Faculty in 1994. He defended his doctoral dissertation in 2001 at the Faculty of Physical Education, University of Novi Sad.

DRAGAN KOKOVIC CV

Dragan Koković was born in Prijepolje (from mother Milica and father Dragiša), on May 1, 1948, where he finished elementary school and high school, and graduated in sociology in Belgrade in 1972. He graduated with his doctoral dissertation entitled "Lifestyle and Culture" on October 2, 1982, at the University of Belgrade.

After graduating from the Department of Sociology at the Faculty of Philosophy in Belgrade, Dr. Dragan Koković worked as a professor at the Branko Radičević High School in Sremski Karlovci, and in 1974 he was elected an assistant at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad. Until his retirement, he was in permanent employment at the mentioned faculty, where he was

elected as a full professor at the Department of Sociology at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad on September 17, 1992.

He made a special contribution to the development of certain contemporary sociological disciplines: sociology of culture, sociology of education, sociology of sports, and sociology of leisure. He is the author of the first textbook on the Sociology of Education in the former Yugoslavia. He is also the author of the first textbook on the Sociology of Sports in Serbia.

He was the Vice President of the Assembly of the University of Novi Sad; President of the Council of the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad; Director of the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology of the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad; President of the Yugoslav Association for the Sociology of Sports; President of the Sociological Society of Serbia; President of the Association of Sociologists of Vojvodina; President of the Commission of the Association of University Teachers and Scientists of Vojvodina for the awarding of prizes to university professors for life's work; Head of the Center for Sports Management (ACIMSI) of the University of Novi Sad.

He is a member of the Serbian Academy of Education, a permanent member-associate of "Matica Srpska", and he was also a member of the Education Council of Vojvodina and a member of the Council for Social and Humanistic Sciences of the Provincial Secretariat for Science and Technological Development.

He is married to his wife Slobodanka and has two children, Jelica (associate professor at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad) and Nenad (graduated economist), and three grandchildren - Nadja (12), Ognjen (8), and Andrija (2).

2. TEACHING ACTIVITY

2.1. Work in the teaching and educational process

Prof. Dr. Dragan Koković taught at all levels of studies at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad. He taught the sociology of education; sociology of culture; sociology of sports, sociology of communication and media, the phenomenology of free time, social anthropology, etc.

Apart from lectures at other faculties of the University of Novi Sad (Faculty of Technology, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Sports and Physical Education, Academy of Arts), he gave cycles of lectures at postgraduate studies in Belgrade, Sarajevo, Nis, Osijek, and Banja Luka. In the wider area of the former SFRY, his works from the sociology of education and sociology of sports stand out, because he processed these, incompletely established areas of sociology in the world, comprehensively and systematized them into clearly expressed subjects, as specified in the domain of modern social science. Therefore, he is one of the first in this field in our country, but also among the representatives of contemporary sociological thought in the field of sociology of education and sociology of sports.

He taught kinesiology sociology (1985-1989) at the Faculty of Education in Osijek, while he taught sociology of culture and art at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad.

In addition to mentoring a large number of graduate and master's theses of students at the Department of Sociology at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad, he was a mentor on over 20 defended doctoral dissertations in the field of sociology of education, sociology of culture, sociology of sports, sociology of mass communications.

He is one of the founders and lecturers of certain areas of modern sociology, such as sociology of education, sociology of sports, sociology of culture, and sociology of leisure, not only in Serbia but also in the former SFR Yugoslavia.

He was one of the founders of the scientific gathering "Village Days of Sreten Vukosavljević", which marks more than a quarter of a century of its existence and successful operation.
